The aim of this event is to celebrate our fantastic Greenway, footpaths and bridle ways including sections of Coventry Way, the Heart of England Way and the Millennium Way. All these will be blocked off by HS2. The aim is also to publicise the loss of Green Belt around Coventry, Kenilworth, Solihull and Meriden.

The High Speed Rail will enter from London north of Stoneleigh to the Greenway at Cromwell Lane Bridge destroying homes, the Village Hall and the Greenway before going on to the east of Berkswell Station, cutting up the countryside and woods in its path to Birmingham. Travelling upward of 225 mph, the plan is to run some 14 trains per hour each way.
